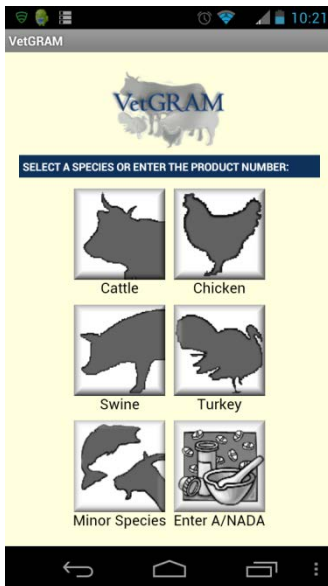


## **VetGRAM Mobile App**

The all new **VetGRAM Mobile App** is available free of charge through the Google app store at <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.farad.vetgram>. This new product is a native application that allows users to carry out user-defined searches and access all information in VetGRAM databases, without the need for internet connectivity. Users with iPhones, iPads or other non-android devices can still access VetGRAM databases through our [mobile-friendly web site](#).

The front page offers a new look, but retains the full functionality of [VetGRAM](#). Select a species for search options or enter the NADA to view label information directly.

- a complete listing of products that are approved for use in food animals
- a convenient list of drugs that are prohibited for use in food-producing animal species
- a list of requirements for legal extra-label drug use (ELDU) in food-producing animal species
- a handy link to the AVMA's Decision Algorithm for ELDU in food animals.
